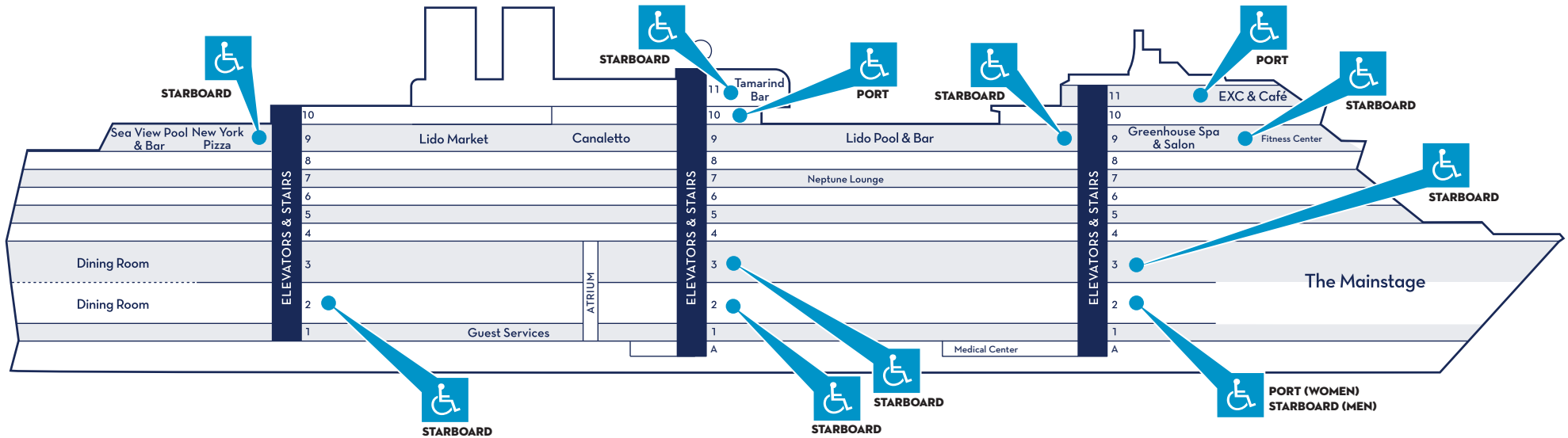


# ACCESSIBILITY GUIDE

## NIEUW AMSTERDAM



**Deck 1** is the Main Deck and is comprised of Staterooms 1001 through 1130. It has two long hallways and both are wheelchair accessible. The three elevator banks that connect the two hallways are also wheelchair accessible, and so is the forward bow.

**Deck 2** is the Lower Promenade Deck. An accessible pathway follows the starboard side of the interior past the stages and public areas and through the center of the interior of the ship. There are four accessible restrooms available in the aft section, at center starboard, and forward on the port and starboard sides.

**Deck 3** is the Promenade Deck. The route is similar in layout to the Deck 2 layout. An accessible path is available midship to connect the port side of the perimeter path to the starboard side. Accessible restrooms are available in the midship and forward areas on the starboard sides.

**Deck 4** is the Upper Promenade Deck and is comprised of Staterooms 4001 through 4187. It has two long hallways and both are wheelchair accessible. The three elevator banks that connect the two hallways are also wheelchair accessible.

**Deck 5** is the Verandah Deck and is comprised of Staterooms 5001 through 5193. It has two long hallways and both are wheelchair accessible. The three elevator banks that connect the two hallways are also wheelchair accessible.

**Deck 6** is the Upper Verandah Deck and is comprised of Staterooms 6001 through 6181. It has two long hallways and both are wheelchair accessible. The three elevator banks that connect the two hallways are also wheelchair accessible.

**Deck 7** is the Rotterdam Deck and is comprised of Staterooms 7001 through 7143. It has two long hallways and both are wheelchair accessible. The three elevator banks that connect the two hallways are also wheelchair accessible.

**Deck 8** is the Navigation Deck and is comprised of Staterooms 8001 through 8179. It has two long hallways and both are wheelchair accessible. The three elevator banks that connect the two hallways are also wheelchair accessible.

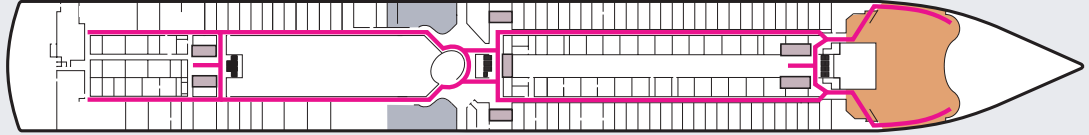
**Deck 9** is the Lido Deck. A wheelchair-accessible route is available along the perimeter, and three hallways connect the port and starboard sides of the deck. Three accessible restrooms are available, all on the starboard side of the ship.

**Deck 10** is the Panorama Deck and is comprised of Staterooms 10001 through 10046. In the forward section of this deck, both hallways are wheelchair accessible. On the remainder of the deck, the perimeter is wheelchair accessible. An accessible restroom is available near the High Score arcade.

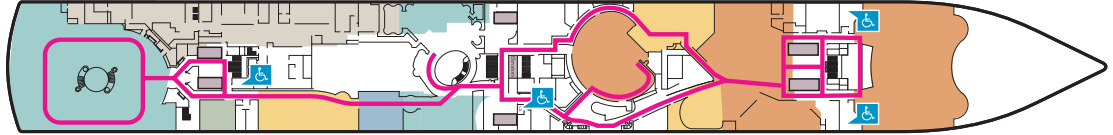
**Deck 11** is the Observation Deck and is comprised of Staterooms 11001 through 11010. The areas near the elevators are wheelchair accessible, but there is no direct path from the front observation area (on the forward side) to the rear observation area. The Crows Nest is located near the forward elevators and the Tamarind and Morimoto restaurants are located near the midship elevators. The forward, midship and rear sections of Deck 11 do not connect and can only be accessed by elevators taken from lower floors. There are accessible restrooms in both areas of Deck 11.

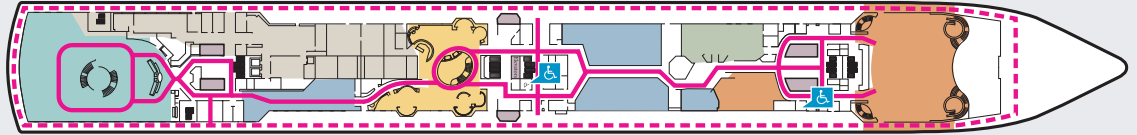
**1** MAIN DECK



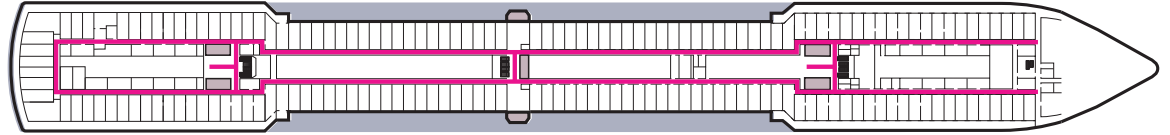
**2** LOWER PROMENADE DECK



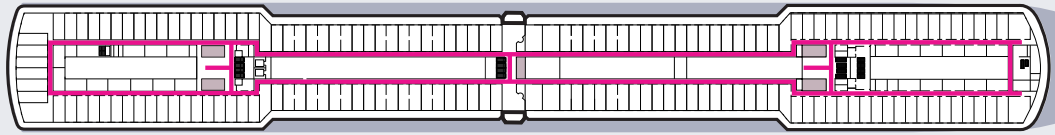
**3** PROMENADE DECK



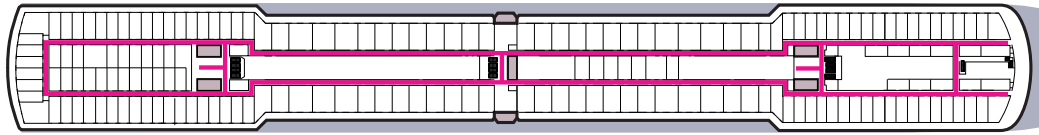
**4** UPPER PROMENADE DECK



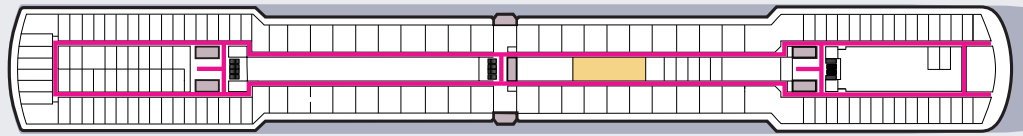
**5** VERDANAH DECK



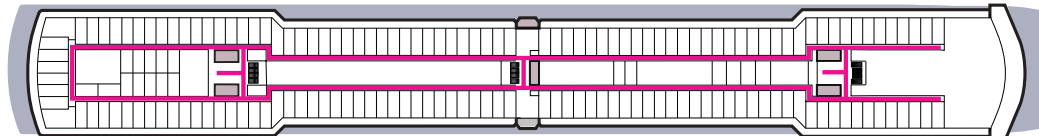
**6** UPPER VERDANAH DECK



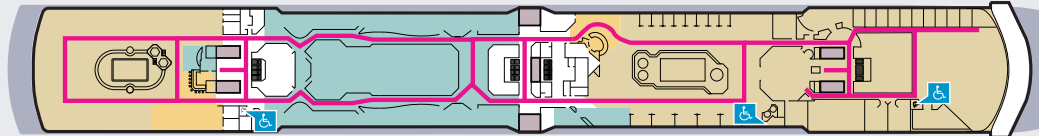
**7** ROTTERDAM DECK



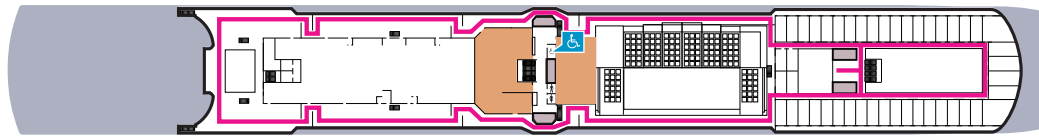
